1. Mandatorily, the titles of all papers should unambiguously reflect the contents of the paper and be in bold capital letters followed by name(s) and affiliations of the author(s) including the e-mail address and phone numbers of the corresponding author for easy reach. The address of the Place where the research was conducted should be given. Avoid the use of titles for Authors.

2. The Abstract should not exceed two hundred and fifty (250) words , clear and concise and should be given the scope, purpose, procedure, significant result and conclusions of the research work.

3. All diagrams, maps and figures should be in CorelDRAW or other acceptable software. Tables and figures should be placed in the appropriate place within the text. Avoid grid lines. These must be prepared in such a way to permit photo reproduction. The minimum character size must be 2.5. Where diagrams and graphs are provided they should be incorporated into the manuscript. Structural formulae should carry Arabic numerals in the text and below the formula which should be drawn neatly within the typed manuscript.

4. Authors are requested to follow the nomenclature and abbreviation that are to be found in other reputable chemistry journals. Specialized terms, unusual abbreviations, trade names and semi ambiguous terms should be defined at first point of use

5. Acknowledgment should be limited to a minimum. All assistance obtained in the form of finance as well as collection of data may be indicated.

6. All Reference cited in the text should bear the Arabic numerals subscript and listed serially at the end of the manuscript. References should be listed in a separate sheet. Follow the method of literature citation in most chemistry journals e.g. J.I. Okogun, T.O. Olagbemiro & A.I Onochukwu (1999), Title of paper, J, Chem, Soc. Nigeria 2,59.
