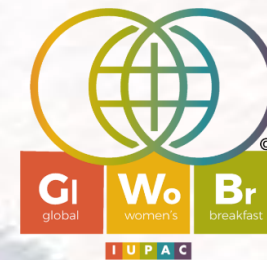

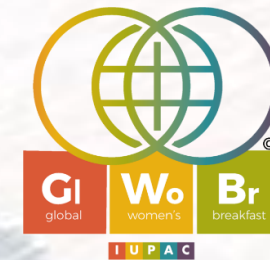


About IUPAC Global Women's Breakfast

About Association of Chemistry Teachers (ACT)

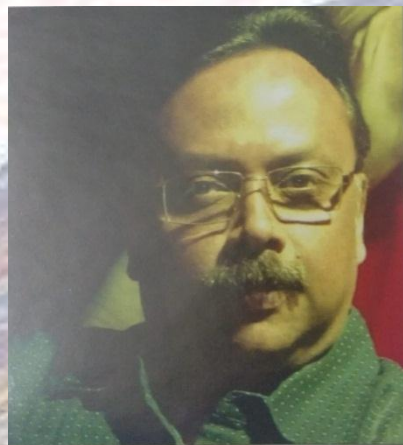
