17/79 INTRODUCTORY REMARKS AND FINALIZATION OF AGENDA

The Agenda drawn up by the Executive Secretary was approved.

18/79 FINANCIAL SUBVENTIONS TO IUPAC-SPONSORED SYMPOSIA

Present IUPAC practice (Appendix G to Minutes, 87th Executive Committee - Washington, 1977) was to decide only at a meeting of the Bureau (Executive Committee) whether to grant a subvention to a sponsored symposium when so requested. A proposal from Prof. Smets was approved that in future all requests for subventions be delegated to the Officers for consideration by correspondence, with the advice of the relevant Division President to be taken into account. Prof. Zollinger suggested that the existing general criteria for granting subventions should be compared with guidelines used by the Organic Chemistry Division Committee.
